Main Folder

In the main directory you see 5 folders.

Real Mock-Up Kit folder contains 68 Mock-Up footage + 5 Footage that are ready to use.

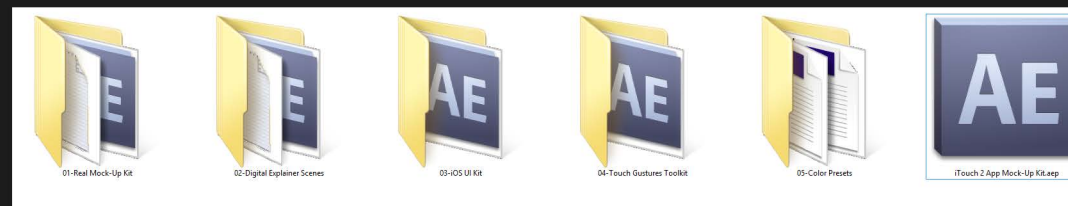
All of them have holder for placing your images.

Digital Explainer Scenes are 3D (Prerenderd) Mock-up and you can use them in "After Effects" easily.

iOS UI Kit folder contains iPhone and iPad elements.

With "Touch Gestures Toolkit" you can use devices , hands or combine them with each other and make perfect scene as you wish.

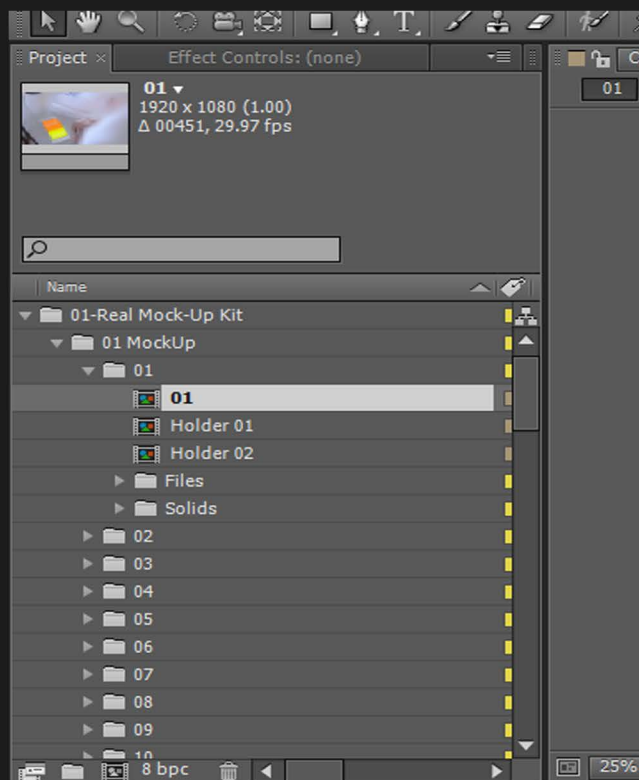
Also, there is "Color Presets" folder.

Real Mock-Up Kit.

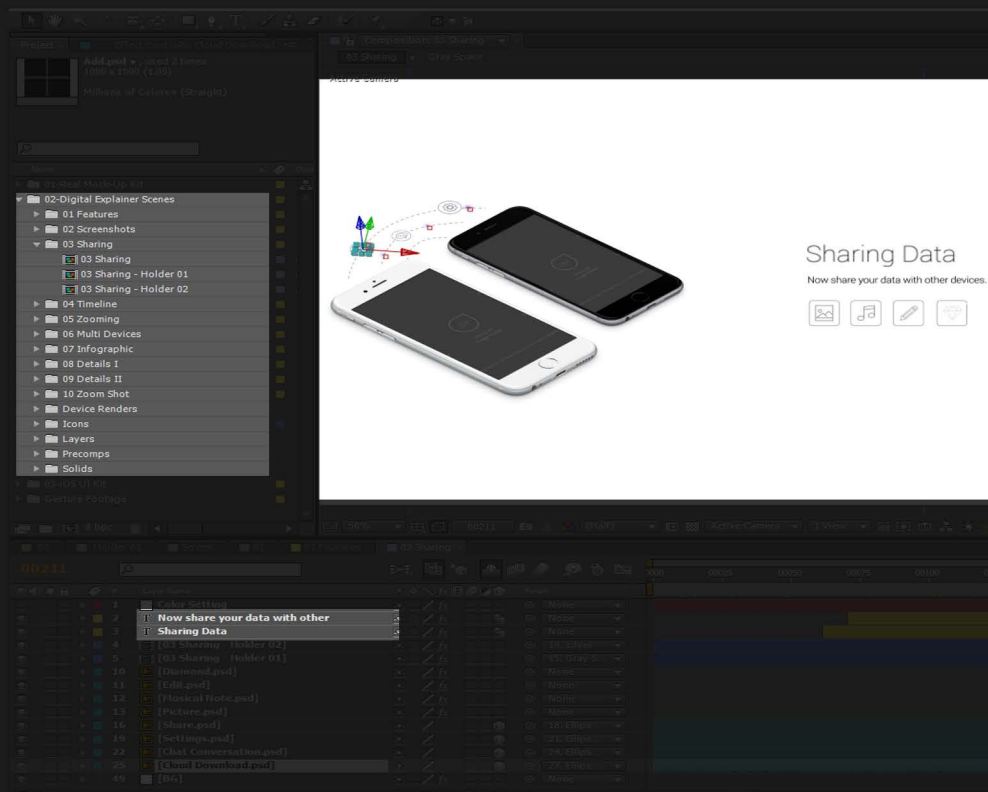
In “Real Mock-Up Kit” there are 68 scenes. Each one has its own image holder and you can import your Image/Video there. Also, there is “02-Footage” folder that its items don't have image holder. You can import them to your project and use them as video footage.

There are 10 digital scenes in the second folder. After opening one them you see they have holder that you can import your Image/Video and the main composition. You can edit the texts or the icons in the layer panel.

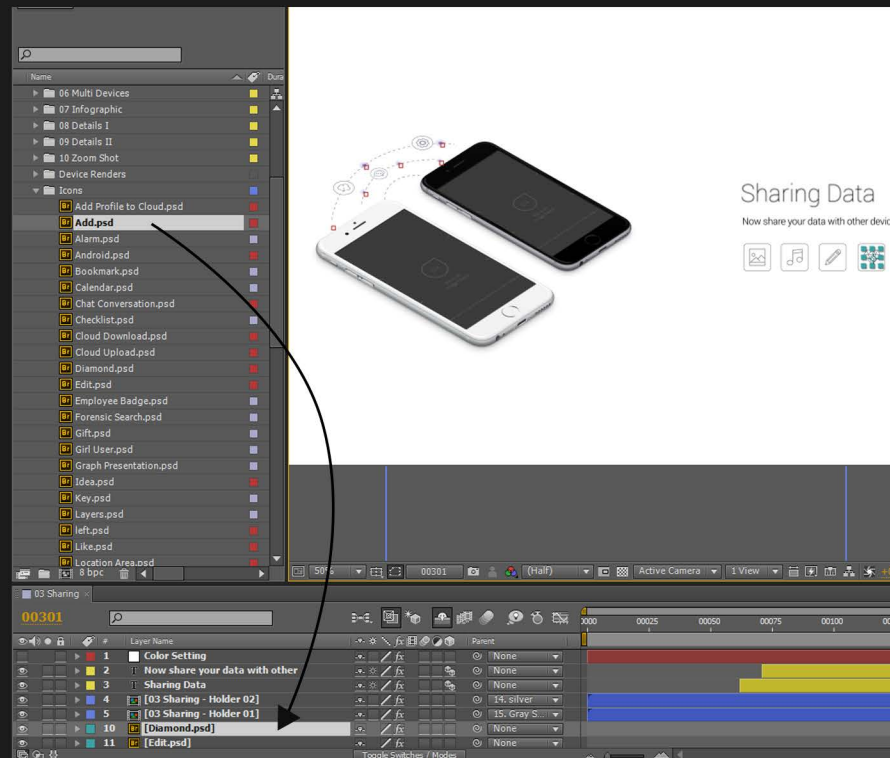

There is an “Icon” folder in “Digital Explainer Scene”. You can edit the scene’s icon by drag and drop from “Icon” Folder in the project panel.

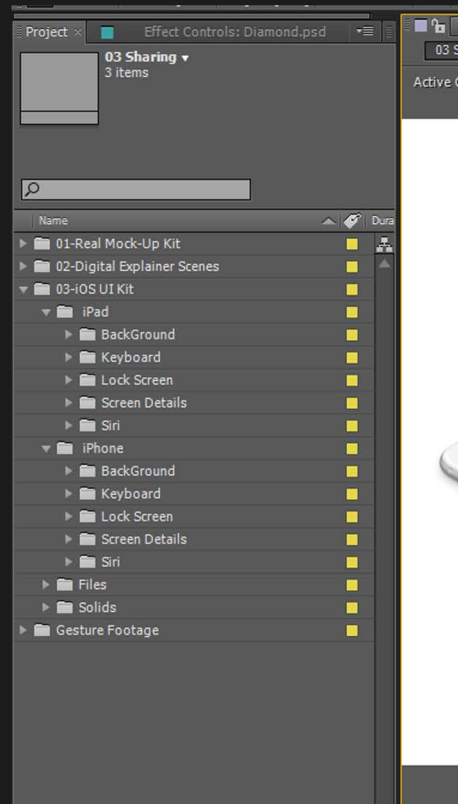
Select the icon in the layer panel and then select the icon in the project panel, now drag and drop by holding “ALT” or “Option” Key.

iOS UI Kit

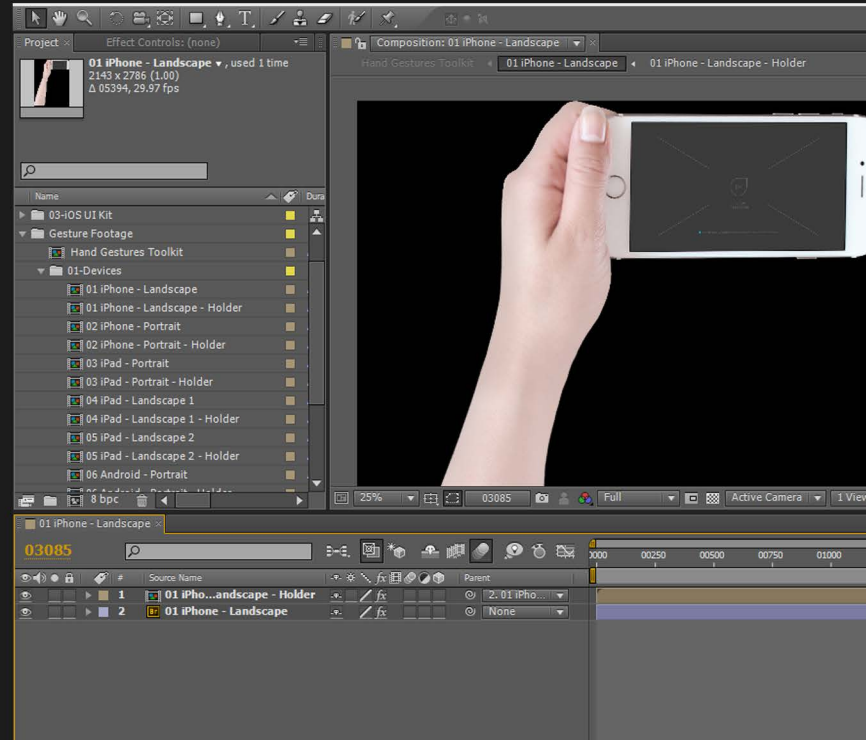
We bring you the “iOS UI Kit”. Select iPhone or iPad folder . There are some elements that you can use them. Just import iOS UI Kit compositions to your mock -Up holders.

Gesture Footage

Gesture footage includes “Devices” and “Gestures” folder. In “Devices” folder you can see 3 different devices. You can import your Video/Image in holder and even you can put a picture from any place you like for background.

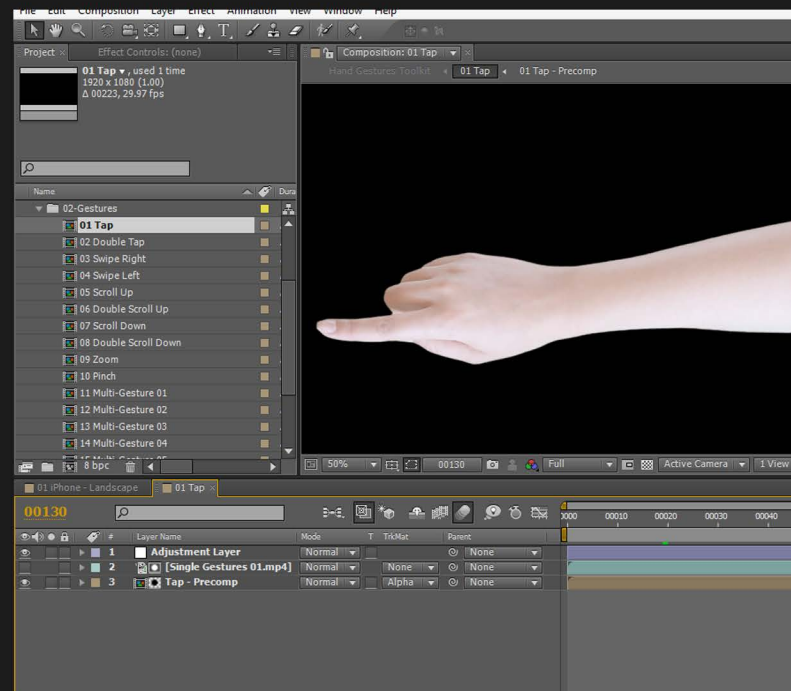

Gesture Footage

In the “Gestures” folder there are several touch gestures. You can select each composition and drag & drop them to the device scene.

You can rotate or scale the gesture composition to fit them as you wish. Also, you can change and make keyframes for the position to have the best result.

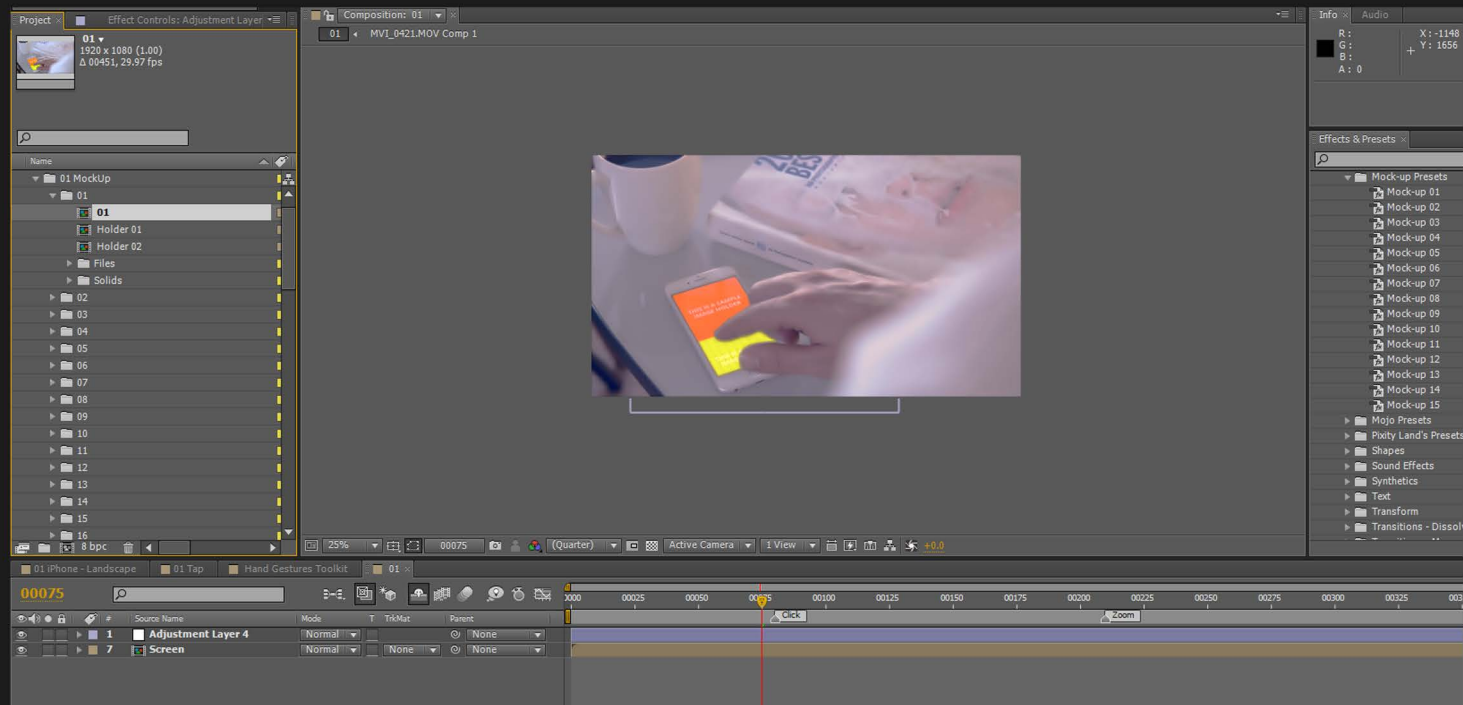


Main Folder

15 Color Presets

In the main folder there is a “Color Presets” Folder. Copy the folder to\Adobe\Adobe After Effects CS...\Support Files\Presets. Open your “After Effects” and find the presets in “Effects & Presets” panel.

Now open your footage Compositions and make an “ Adjustment Layer ” by pressing “Alt”+“Ctrl”+“Y”, drag & drop the presets to the layer and see the changes.
